## VILLAGE OF NAVARRE, OHIO ORDINANCE 12-2020

### ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CLERK-TREASURER TO ACCEPT “CARES” ACT FUNDS, AMENDING ORDINANCE 3-2020 (PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS), AND CREATING SEPARATE FUND TO ACCEPT AND HOLD “CARES” ACT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, (the CARES Act) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the “Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act” in Senate Bill 310 of the 133<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly (S.B. 310); and

WHEREAS, S.B. 310 requires that political subdivisions receiving funds under Section 1 of the Act, pass a resolution affirming that funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund may be expended only to cover costs of the political subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations before receiving said funds; and

WHEREAS, the Stark County Board of Commissioners has requested and anticipates receipt of its share of funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Navarre, Ohio is requesting its share of funds distributed to Stark County from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund; and, therefore be it

ORDAINED by the Village Council of Navarre, Ohio that

Section 1. The Village of Navarre requests from the Stark County Board of Commissioners its share of Stark County’s funds received by Stark County from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund.

Section 2. All funds received by the Village of Navarre from Stark County’s share of the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund pursuant to S.B. 310 shall be deposited into a separate account.

Section 3. All such funds are appropriated for and shall be expended only to cover costs of the Village of Navarre consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations and guidance, only to cover expenses that:

- (a) Are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);
- (b) Were not accounted for in the Village of Navarre’s most recently approved budget as of March 27, 2020; and
- (c) Were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30, 2020.

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Section 4. The Village of Navarre Administrator and Clerk-Treasurer shall take the following actions and all other necessary actions to remain in compliance with S.B. 310:

(a) On or before October 15, 2020, pay any unencumbered balance of money in the Village's local coronavirus relief fund to the Stark County Treasurer; and

(b) Provide any information related to any payments received under S.B. 310 to the Stark County, Ohio Auditor or Treasurer, or to the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management as requested; and

(c) The Village of Navarre Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and instructed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Stark County Auditor and to the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management, as required and appropriate.

Section 5. This Ordinance, containing an additional appropriation, amends Ordinance 3-2020 (Permanent Appropriations for 2020).

Section 6. This Ordinance, inasmuch as its prompt passage is required to ensure that the Village of Navarre receives its estimated allocable share of the Stark County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund, without which Ordinance, it will not receive any such funds, and further inasmuch as the Village of Navarre anticipates that it will incur costs related to the Covid-19 disease, is deemed an EMERGENCY, and is thus passed without three readings, and in accordance with applicable law permitting such passage of emergency ordinances. This Ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its passage by Council and being signed by the Mayor.
