ORDINANCE NO. 13-2018

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR
TO ADVERTISE AND RECEIVE BIDS FOR COLLECTION OF
RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE, RUBBISH, AND RECYCLABLES
WITHIN VILLAGE FOR THREE YEAR PERIOD

Whereas, the Village's residents are currently served by a number of private providers of garbage, rubbish, and recyclable collection, and

Whereas, some of such providers constitute a hazard to persons, property, and traffic within the Village, and

Whereas, the Village believes that its residents can receive cost savings on such services if the Village contracts to aggregate such services from a single provider to provide such to Village residents at a lower cost than residents could obtain on their own,

Now Therefore, the Village Council of Navarre, Ohio resolves and ordains as follows:


The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids according to specification to be established by said Village Administrator, and the Mayor shall, upon an award by Village Council, be authorized to enter into an exclusive franchise agreement for the collection of residential garbage, rubbish, and recyclables within the Village for a three year period commencing November 1, 2018 and terminating October 31, 2021,

Provided that the Village may reject all bids and not enter into any such agreement, in the sole discretion of the Village, acting through its Council, Mayor, and Administrator.

This ordinance has been passed as an emergency, with the requisite number of votes required to dispense with three readings, and shall go into effect immediately upon the approval of this ordinance by Village Council and the Mayor. The emergency is that the Village must provide for the health and welfare of its residents, and seeks immediate cost relief for its residents and immediate reduction of traffic by waste trucks operated by multiple waste haulers.
