ORDINANCE NO. 15-2019

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 97.99 OF THE VILLAGE
OF NAVARRE CODIFIED MUNICIPAL REGULATIONS

Whereas, the Codified Municipal Regulations of the Village of Navarre presently contain two penalty sections under Chapter 97, relating to income tax offenses, said sections being 97.99 and 97.991 (the latter of which is in the book provided by American Legal Publishing as Sec. 97.98), and Sec. 97.99 contains penalties that appear to conflict with those contained within Sec. 97.991, and

Whereas, Sec. 97.991 is the more recently passed section, and is the latest statement of Village Council as to what penalties are appropriate for violations of Chapter 97, and

Whereas, Sec. 97.991 was adopted in Ordinance 11-2015, duly passed by Village Council, and has never been repealed, and

Whereas, Village Council desires to clarify the applicable penalties under Chapter 97,


Now Therefore, the Village Council of Navarre, Ohio Ordains as follows:

Section 1 – Section 97.99 of the Codified Municipal Regulations is repealed,
and


Section 2 – Section 97.991 of the Codified Municipal Regulations (Section 97.98 in the current Codified Municipal Regulations book published by American Legal Publishing), which covers the matters previously covered in Section 97.99, shall remain in full force and effect, and

Section 3 – American Legal Publishing is hereby directed to renumber Section 97.98 in its book to Section 97.991.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency, as it removes any overlap or uncertainty in penalties for violations of Chapter 97 of the Codified Municipal Regulations, which is of urgent need by taxpayers, and enforcing officials and tribunals, and is thus approved by Village Council with the requisite majority required for adopting an emergency ordinance, and waiving the three readings rule. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
