ORDINANCE NO. 15-2020

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AMENDMENT OF CONTRACT FOR STERILITE STREET N. E., EXTENSION PROJECT

Whereas the Village of Navarre entered into a contract for a certain construction project, "Sterilite Street NE Extension," with United Earthworks, LLC, in the sum of \$719,901, and

Whereas, United Earthworks has submitted two applications for change orders, the first being for undercut work performed by Wenger Excavating (as United Earthworks' subcontractor) in the sum of \$12,491.60, and the second being for undercut work performed by its own forces in the sum of \$40,000, for a total of \$52,491.60, and


Whereas, the engineer on the project, John E. Walsh, of GBC Design, Inc. has reviewed the change order applications and found them to be reasonable and supportable, and

Whereas, the Village has a commitment from the developer, Stark Board of Trade, LLC, to provide funds for said change orders,

Now Therefore, The Village Council of Navarre, Ohio Ordains and Authorizes the Village Administrator to approve said change orders in the total sum of \$52,491.60, and further Ordains and Authorizes payment on said change orders to be made in the sum of \$52,491.60, under the authority of Resolution No. 2020-6; provided, however, that prior to approval of said change orders and payment therefor, the Clerk-Treasurer shall certify receipt of adequate funds to pay for said change orders.

Wherefore, this Ordinance will take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by council and approval by the Mayor. Further, Council declares that this Ordinance is an Emergency, being reasonably necessary for the fiscal well being of the Village, particularly inasmuch as the Village desires that its contractor, United Earthworks, be paid for its work in a timely fashion. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be passed with the number of votes necessary to waive the three reading rule and be adopted as an Emergency measure.
