ORDINANCE NO. 18-2020

AN ORDINANCE AWARING CONTRACT FOR 2020 PUBLIC STREET PAVING FOR PLAINMONT STREET, SPRANKLE STREET, JACOB STREET, BENDER STREET, AND OAKBROOK STREET, TO N. E. S. CORP.

Whereas the Village of Navarre, Ohio publicly advertised for sealed bids for a certain construction project, "2020 Public Street Paving for Plainmont Street, Sprankle Street, Jacob Street, Bender Street, and Oakbrook Street" (the Project), in accordance with applicable provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, and

Whereas, on August 25, 2020, sealed bids were opened, and the low bidder was N. E. S. Corp., in the sum of \$216,305, for Items 1 through 13, and 20 through 22, part of which is lump sum and part of which is unit prices, and

Whereas, the N. E. S. bid was below the Engineer's estimate, and the Engineer has determined that, under all of the circumstances, the N. E. S. bid is the "best bid," as provided for in Section 12 of the Instructions to Bidders, and

Whereas, the N. E. S. bid qualifies under either applicable legal standard, those being "lowest and best," and "lowest responsible bidder," and

Whereas, time is of the essence, as the Project needs to be completed before the onset of inclement weather, which weather could impact the long term quality of work on the Project,

*Now Therefore, The Village Council of Navarre, Ohio Ordains and Authorizes the Village Administrator to enter into a contract with N. E. S. Corp., in a form acceptable to the Village Solicitor, in the amount of the \$216,305..*

Wherefore, this ordinance will take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by council and approval by the Mayor. Further, Council declares that this ordinance, being reasonably necessary for the fiscal wellbeing of the Village, particularly inasmuch as the Village desires that this Project commence as quickly as possible so as to be completed before the onset of inclement weather, with the number of votes necessary to waive the three reading rule and adopt this measure as an Emergency.
