ORDINANCE NO. 2-2020

AN ORDINANCE AWARDDING A CONTRACT ON STERILITE STREET  
N. E., EXTENSION PROJECT, TO UNITED EARTHWORKS, LLC

Whereas the Village of Navarre, Ohio publicly advertised for sealed bids for a certain construction project, "Sterilite Street NE Extension," in accordance with applicable provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, and

Whereas, on December 31, 2019, sealed bids were opened, and the low bidder was United Earthworks, LLC, in the sum of \$719,901, with work to be completed within one-hundred forty (140) days,

Whereas, the United Earthworks bid appears to be responsive to the invitation to bid, and United Earthworks itself appears to be a responsible bidder, and

Whereas, it is believed that under all of the circumstances, that United Earthworks' bid is the lowest and best for the Village of Navarre, Ohio,

*Now Therefore, The Village Council of Navarre, Ohio Ordains and Authorizes the Village Administrator to enter into a contract for the project with United Earthworks, LLC, on terms consistent with its bid, provided that the form of the contract is deemed acceptable by the Village Solicitor and that the Clerk-Treasurer certifies the availability of funds,*

Wherefore, this ordinance will take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by council and approval by the Mayor. Further, Council declares that this ordinance is an Emergency, being reasonably necessary for the fiscal well being of the Village, particularly inasmuch as the Village desires that this project commence as quickly as possible so as to meet the timeline for the Hendrickson industrial project to come on-line with significant employment within the Village, and be completed early enough in 2020 that further industrial development can be procured for the Prospect Park industrial park, to be passed with the number of votes necessary to waive the three reading rule and adopt this measure as an Emergency.
