Whereas, on July 2, 2018, the Village of Navarre passed Ordinance 12-2018 accepting annexation of the Navarre-Bethlehem Community Park, and


Whereas, the annexation map and ordinance were recorded with Stark County Recorder, on July 30, 2018, as Instruments 201807300029809 and 201807300029810, thus completing the annexation, and

Whereas, a condition of said annexation is that the Village enter into an agreement with Stark County for the shared maintenance of certain roads affected by the annexation, namely parts of Fohl Street, Hudson Drive, and Blough Avenue, which proposed agreement has been prepared by the Stark County Engineer, and has been reviewed by the Village Administrator and Village Solicitor, and

Now Therefore, Village Council Resolves as follows –

That the Village Administrator is authorized to enter into the maintenance agreement with Stark County in the form presented before Village Council and acceptable to the Village Solicitor.


