RESOLUTION NO. 2019-1

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT STARK COUNTY ENGINEER  
LOWER SPEED LIMIT ON HUDSON DRIVE WHERE IT IS ADJACENT  
TO NAVARRE-BETHLEHEM COMMUNITY PARK TO 25 MPH

Whereas, on July 2, 2018, the Village of Navarre passed Ordinance 12-2018, accepting annexation into the Village of the Navarre-Bethlehem Community Park, and

Whereas, as a result of said annexation, the speed limit in the north (west-bound) lane of travel on Hudson Drive, immediately adjacent to said Community Park, is twenty-five (25) miles per hour, but the speed limit in the south lane of travel (east-bound) is significantly greater, at forty (40) miles per hour, and

Whereas, across from said Community Park is parkland owned by the Stark County Board of Commissioners, as a result of which there is regular foot traffic from one side of the road to the other, and the parklands and parking areas on both side of the road are frequently used by minors, and

Whereas, Council has determined that public safety would be best served if the speed limit in both lanes of travel on Hudson Drive, immediately adjacent to said Community Park, was twenty-five (25) miles per hour,

Now Therefore, Village Council Resolves as follows -


That the Village, through its Administrator, should take such action as required to seek to have the County Engineer equalize the speed limit in both lanes of travel on Hudson Drive, immediately adjacent to the Navarre-Bethlehem Community Park, to twenty-five (25) miles per hour.
