ORDINANCE NO. 5-2018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VILLAGE PAY
ORDINANCE 16-2017

Whereas, on September 18, 2017, Village Council enacted Ordinance 16-2017, setting forth the salaries, wages, holidays, vacation time and pay, and job descriptions of various employees and other officials of the Village of Navarre, Stark County, Ohio, and

Whereas, Village Council deems it prudent to amend Sections 3(E), 4(C), and 14(G) of said Ordinance 16-2017

Now Therefore, the Village Council of Navarre, Ohio amends Sections 3(E), 4(C), and 14(G) of Ordinance 16-2017, as set forth below, while leaving the remainder of said Ordinance 16-2017 unchanged and remaining in full force:

SECTION 3 – E. Persons being paid under subsections A through D above [in Sec. 3 – “Street Department”], who have a certificate as an ASE Certified Mechanic, shall be paid an additional \$0.97 per hour, and persons who obtain such certificate shall, commencing with the next pay period after obtaining such certification, be paid an additional \$0.97 per hour.

SECTION 4 – C. ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT – WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (must hold and maintain at least a Class II wastewater treatment license): For the year commencing with the first regular pay of January, 2018: \$20.50/hour, and for the year commencing with the first regular pay of January, 2019 and thereafter: \$21.10/hour.

SECTION 14 – G. CEMETERY SEXTON: For the year commencing with the first regular pay of January 2018, and thereafter: \$2,000 per year, provided that said pay rate shall take effect upon appointment of a Cemetery Sexton immediately following enactment of this Ordinance, and pay for the 2018 year shall be pro-rated for the portion of 2018 actually worked by the newly appointed Cemetery Sexton.

Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approved by the Mayor. Further, Council declares that this ordinance, being reasonably necessary for the health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Navarre, particularly as it relates to the rate of pay for a person newly appointed to the position of Cemetery Sexton, and should therefore be passed as an EMERGENCY, with the number of votes necessary to waive the three readings rule and adopt this measure as an EMERGENCY.
