ORDINANCE NO. 6-2019

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PLACEMENT AND
BLOWING OF SNOW AND GRASS ONTO SIDEWALKS
AND NEIGHBORING PROPERTIES, ENACTING
NEW MUNICIPAL REGULATION 153.08.

Whereas, the Village has a vested interest in protecting the unobstructed flow and safety of pedestrian and other traffic over its sidewalks, and in protecting property owners and tenants within the Village from nuisances from adjoining properties,

Now Therefore, the Village Council of Navarre, Ohio enacts new Section 153.08 as part of its permanent Municipal Regulations.

Section 153.08 – Placing or blowing snow or Grass onto sidewalks or adjoining properties

No person, occupying any real property within the Village, whether as an owner, tenant, or other form of occupant, or acting on behalf of an owner, tenant, or occupant, shall knowingly cause snow or Grass to be removed from one property and be unreasonably blown or otherwise placed upon sidewalks or the real property of another person, without the Village's consent or the other person's express consent or without removing such snow or Grass within a reasonable period of time thereafter. Nor shall any such person knowingly push or blow snow from said person's real property (whether such person is an owner, tenant or other form of occupant) onto the streets and alleys of the Village.

Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
