ORDINANCE 7-2020

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ENTERING INTO COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AGREEMENT WITH STARK
COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

Whereas, the current community development block grant agreement between the Board of Commissioners of Stark County, Ohio and the Village of Navarre is due expire June 30, 2020, and must be renewed for a three year period, and

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of Stark County, Ohio has notified the Village of Navarre that it must take immediate action to renew the Village's participation in that program, and

Whereas, it is manifestly in the best interest of the Village of Navarre that it continue to participate in the County's community development block grant agreement, and

Whereas, the Village Solicitor has deemed the proposed agreement between the Board of Commissioners of Stark County and the Village of Navarre to be lawful and in proper form,

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Navarre, Ohio, that the Mayor or the Village Administrator are authorized to execute, on behalf of the Village of Navarre, the proposed community development block grant agreement in the form that has been reviewed and approved by the Village Solicitor.


This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law. This ordinance is deemed an EMERGENCY, not requiring three readings, the Emergency being that time is of the essence for the Village of Navarre to enter into the community development block grant agreement and return the same to the Board of Commissioners of Stark County, to assure that the Village of Navarre may continue to participate in this program for another three years, and should therefore be passed as an EMERGENCY, with the number of votes necessary to waive the three readings rule and adopt this measure as an EMERGENCY.
