ORDINANCE NO. 9-2020

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING NEW SECTION 10.19 OF THE  
VILLAGE OF NAVARRE CODIFIED MUNICIPAL REGULATIONS

Whereas, the Codified Municipal Regulations of the Village of Navarre presently contain numerous provisions where, before the Village may take an official action against a person, a notice of violation of a prohibition must be delivered to the person by certified mail, return receipt requested, and

Whereas, a recurring problem is that persons to whom such certified mail notices are sent simply refuse to accept or take delivery of them, which conduct frustrates the Village's ability to enforce its codified municipal regulations, and

Whereas, an alternate means of providing notice of violation is required in the event that persons to whom such are sent refuse to accept or take delivery of such notices,

Now Therefore, the Village Council of Navarre, Ohio Ordains as follows, by enacting new Sections 10.19, in its General Provisions, which shall read:


Section 10.19 – Alternate means of providing notice of violation to persons who refuse, do not accept, or do not take delivery of certified mail service of notices.

*"Whenever any section of these Municipal Regulations requires that the Village serve a notice of violation by certified mail before taking further action against the intended recipient of the notice of violation, and if attempted service of a notice of violation by certified mail is refused, and the certified mail envelope shows such refusal, or if attempted service of a notice of violation by certified mail is returned with an endorsement stating the envelope was unclaimed, the Village official that sent such notice may serve the intended recipient of the notice with a copy of the notice of violation by ordinary United States mail. Service of such notice of violation shall be deemed to have been completed in accord with the applicable section of these Municipal Regulations on the fourth business day after such notice of violation is mailed from a United States post office."*


This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor.
